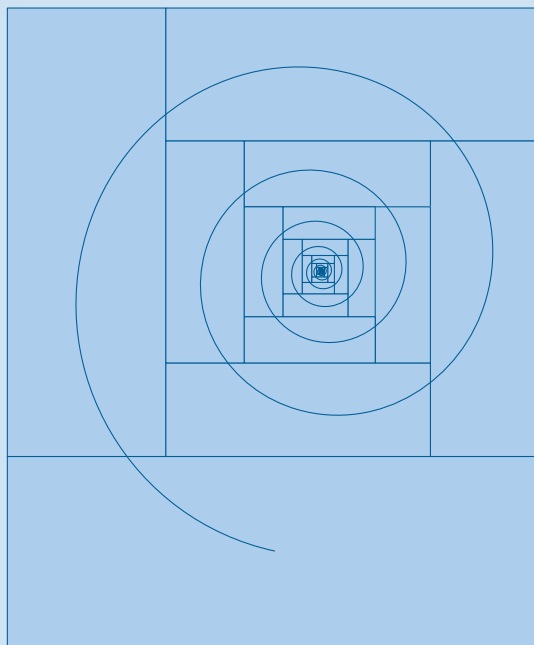




TEX Gyre: The New Font Project

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The former is the Latin Modern family of fonts, i.e., a collection of 92 fonts (72 text and 20 math ones) in the POSTSCRIPT Type 1 and OTF formats, based on the Computer Modern fonts, equipped with a rich repertoire of diacritical characters.

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The latter is a GUST project, launched in 1996, aimed at supplementing Adobe's 35 basic fonts with a rich repertoire of diacritical characters (the working name was *Qfonts*).

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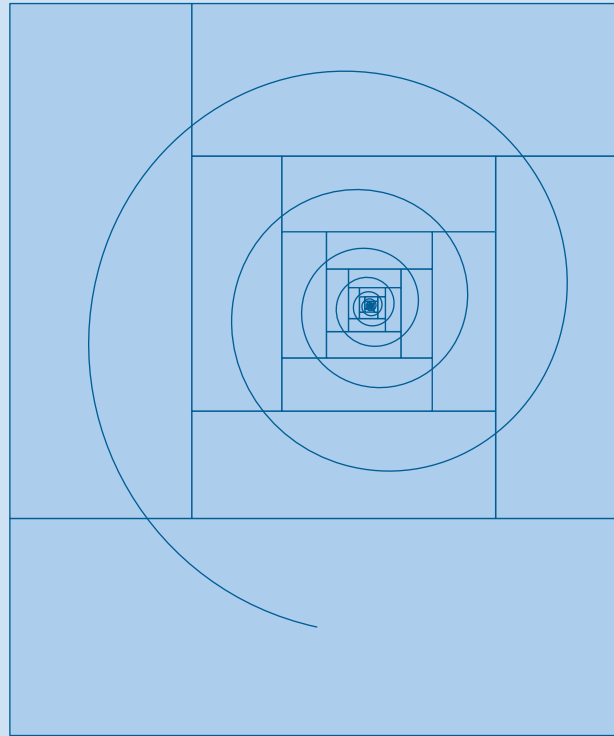
