\if plaiting

Suppose we have

```
\let\ifouter=\iftrue
\ifouter <true code> \else <>false code> \fi
```

and suppose that in true block there is another \if test that has to be built using \csname..\endcsname.

```
\expandafter\let\csname if@inner\endcsname\iftrue
```

Does the following work?

```
\ifouter
  \csname if@inner\endcsname
  <double true code>
  \csname fi\endcsname
\else
  <>false code>
\fi
```

Only if the inner test is true. Otherwise the condition will not be balanced. But we can plait \if blocks as in

```
\ifouter
  \iftrue
  \csname if@inner\endcsname
  <triple true code>
  % \else % does not spoil the game
  \fi
  \csname fi\endcsname
\else
  <>false code>
\fi
```
