Null control sequence

When you do:

```
\endlinechar=-1  
\let\x\
```

the macro `\x` is undefined...

Actually `\x` becomes equal to the null control sequence that you would get from

```
\expandafter\def\csname\endcsname{}
```

but that is usually undefined.

And you can even use this effect to assign to the null control sequence without needing `\expandafter`:

```
\endlinechar=-1  
\gdef\  
  {\message{NULL CS}}  
  
\csname\endcsname
```
